

What are the issues that have arisen?



Quality Assurance of Software

- Strong Software
 - Beyond "drill and practice"
 - Embracing Learning Styles preferences multimedia text, audio, video, 3D
 - Encouraging creativity
 - Imaginative use of application software
 - Virtual learning environments including learning journals and personal learning plans
 - Customised in line with OBE principles
 - Web based software resources
- Screening, evaluation and verification frameworks

FS impediments and barriers

Human Resources:

- Lack of staff time and administrative support.
- Succession of IT dept expertise; salary implications
- Lack of available project staff from Curriculum and IT
- Lack of ICT training capacity throughout the system
- Empty posts for the ICT programme start
- -Lapa scanning staff and resources required

FS impediments and barriers

Financial Resources:

- Action and procurement delayed between Dec-April because of the gap between one financial system and another (normally run in parallel)
- UK team have 4 more days in budget?
- Connectivity:
 - Telkom restrictions on broadband delivery and pricing strategy is prohibitive

What priorities are being proposed for 2004?



Recommendations

- Requirement for negotiations at high level with Telkom Foundation not Telkom Sales
- Need to establish a FS Telkom education representative
- Immediate staffing budget for Fast Gains programme
- Teacher secondees to the Curriculum department
- More staffing in the FS IT Department to give continuous support
- Outsourcing 'one stop shop' support and maintenance
- Need for an advisory team of ICT lead learners

Partnership Companies recommendations

Partnership with the FS signalled by logos on the Lapa website

Companies especially black empowerment 'encouraged' to visit BETT04 to raise knowledge and understanding of the world market and look for effective partnerships

FS and Company funded practice based classroom projects for evidence base and research into SA resource needs and usage

Send proposal to Telkom for video conferencing facilities and scholarship bursaries
